IB Career-related Programme Business & Hospitality Management

SSHL is a candidate school for the International Baccalaureate (IB) Career-related Programme and pursuing authorization as an IB World School. IB World Schools share a common philosophy – a commitment to improve the teaching and learning of a diverse and inclusive community of students by delivering challenging, high quality programmes of international education that share a powerful vision.***

The IB career-related programme in Business & Hospitality Management at SSSL is a two year programme which combines academic studies with career related/practical studies, for example workplace experiences.

At SSSL, the student will study three diploma programme subjects to secure competence for further studies. In the IB Career-related Programme core, the student will study courses, which focus on *Business & Hospitality Management*.
