

Subject option list for IB Diploma Programme at SSHL

Below are the option columns available for the IB Diploma Programme for students starting **August 2025**. The option columns are determined by scheduling and staffing of classes. Students choose their options by completing a google form online. The link will be sent to students by email once accepted to the programme. Carefully read the following guidelines:

- Students can choose only one course from each of the option columns (as subjects in the same option column are scheduled at the same time).
- Students must choose at least one Language A course.
- Students must choose at least one Science: Chemistry/ Physics/ Biology/Sports, Exercise and Health Science (SEHS), Environmental Systems and Societies (ESS)
- Students must choose at least oneIndividuals & Societies: Business Management/Economics/Global Politics/History/Philosophy/Environmental Systems and Societies (ESS)
- Students must have 3 Higher Level (HL) and 3 Standard Level (SL) subjects.
- You can read further information on each subject via the IB DP Subject Briefs.
- Other language courses can be requested. If there is enough interest, we may be able to offer it.
- Additional courses can be selected from Pamoja (the IB online course provider) at extra cost.

^{*} If you have another mother tongue other than English or Swedish you can take this language as a "School Supported Self Taught Language A Literature SL" as long as it is offered by the IB. SSST Lang A may also be taken as a third language to replace a subject in Option Column 4-6. Please contact Adrian Feehan for further information.

- Groups that are very small may not be started in which case the student will have to change their options. Class sizes are limited so students may also have to change their options if a class is full.
- It is the student/family's responsibility to make sure that the subjects they choose are sufficient for entry into the university of their choice. For example, requirements for German universities can be viewed here. Contact syv@sshl.se for further guidance if required.
- Swedish A SL/HL is required to be accepted onto Swedish university courses. If a student is taking Swedish B they must complement their language qualifications by taking a TISUS test (Test in Swedish for University Studies).
