Enterprise and Entrepreneurship

The IB career-related programme in Enterprise and Entrepreneurship at SSHL is a two year programme which combines academic studies with career related/practical studies, for example workplace experiences.

At SSHL, students will study three diploma programme subjects to secure competence for further studies. The IB Career-related Programme core, enhances students' personal qualities and professional development with a specific focus on their career path of *Enterprise and Entrepreneurship*.

The programme has three parts:

1. DP subjects

- 2. Language A
- 3. A choice of DP subjects offered at SSHL (limited by the option list columns)
